### **Maribyrnong Orchid Spring Show – 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> September**

I wish to remind all members who are selling plants at the Spring Show that Hall set up is from 12.30pm on the Friday preceding the show. All Orchid entries are from 1pm - 6.30pm.

#### Please remember the following rules:-

- Members can only exhibit and sell orchids only at the Spring Show.
- All plant entries that are exhibited at any show, must have been owned and grown by the exhibiting member, for a minimum of six months.
- The only person that can move plants from one room to another in the sales area is the Show Co-ordinator. So members please do not re-arrange plants.

The Sales area closes at 4.30pm on Sunday to enable members in this area to start the clean up. **You are therefore required to collect your unsold plants at 4.30pm.** Sales tickets must be removed and checked off on your sales sheet before taking plants away.

The Show area stays open till 5pm. The show area is cleaned up after that time.
